- All staff have a responsibility to be of assistance to the families within our community

- Staff should not write on children's work (unless they ask you to)
- All staff should greet other people consistently and positively
- All staff should feel able to express themselves and communicate with each other
- All staff/teams should take regular opportunities to reflect on their practice
- All staff should be flexible about where they work
- All staff should take turns inside/outside/trips
- All staff should be positive role models
- All staff should keep to time
- · All staff should attend meetings and inset where agreed
- All staff should keep their paperwork up to date

- All staff and children should be involved with tidying up

- All learning areas must be supervised
